Some **Twitter** users were recently duped into paying money for a security system they did not need. **accounts to CNET News**. In the scam, **Twitter** users were directed to a web site that featured a **YouTube** video titled "Best Video." If you attempted to watch the video, you'd be hit with a slow-loading page that said your computer was infected with a virus.

M16 chief blows his cover as wife's Facebook account reveals family holidays, showbiz friends and links to David Irving

The new head of M16 has been left exposed by a major personal security breach after his wife published intimate photographs and family details on the Facebook website.

Sir John Sawers is due to take over as chief of the Secret Intelligence Service in November, putting him in charge of all Britain's spying operations abroad.

But his wife's entries on the social networking site have exposed potentially compromising details about where they live and work, who their friends are and where they spend their holidays. Amazingly, she had put virtually no privacy controls on her account, making it visible to anyone on her 200million users who chose to connect to her. The "London" network - which they actually
