- Needed a new platform to act as a warehouse for all the incident management documentation and information/resources
- Asked for a new share drive
  - Limitations to access by outside partners
- Didn't want to try to learn a new system in the middle of a crisis

# Useful SharePoint Features

- Can create new sub-sites for each event/incident
- Secure access for partners
- Can set different access to pages, libraries, etc
- Common calendar
- Libraries to organize content
- Links to resources, sites

# Why SharePoint

- Common picture of response activities, resources, and needs
- Improved communication and access to information
- Documentation for management of the incident
- Easy to use/learn



# Where we're going

- Movement of all material from old “secure portal” web access for partners to SharePoint
  - Grant management
  - Emergency plans and resources uploaded
  - Disaster exercise notifications for all public health
  - Partners upload exercise lessons learned, etc
  - More closely work with hospitals in emergency situations, create site to support them

# Stumbling Blocks

- Access limited to WV.gov addresses without working through OT. Limitations for response partners to access information.
- SharePoint not always compatible with some software features (ex. Google Earth)
