# SOCIAL MEDIA

- If Facebook was a country, it would have the third largest population with 1.11 billion
- It has 665 million active users

# MOBILE

- Of the 6.8 billion people on the planet, 5.1 billion now have cell phones
- 75% of emails opened  
60% of Facebook posts  
90% of tweets  
are all conducted from a mobile device

# ANALYTICS

- 90% of the data in the world today has been created in the last two years alone
- Only 0.5% of data is analyzed today

# CLOUD COMPUTING

- 80% of new commercial apps will be deployed on cloud platforms
- Cloud computing market will grow from about 41 billion to 241 billion in 2020
