Big Funding for Transit, Port, and Infrastructure Security projects

On May 16, 2008 the Department of Homeland Security announced funding for the Infrastructure Protection Program. Over the next three months, the program will provide over \$840 million in funding for Transit, Port and Infrastructure security. These programs can all fund Sprint through Authorized Equipment List category 06CC (interoperable Communications Equipment- Commercial), and may qualify under other categories as well.

Transit Security Grant Program (TSGP)

The TSGP provides grant funding to the nation's key high-threat urban areas to enhance security measures for their critical transit infrastructure including bus, ferry and rail systems.

TSGP Allowable Costs: Allowable expenses must fall under one of the following categories:

1. Planning
2. Operational Packages
- 3. Equipment Acquisitions**

TSGP funds may be used for the following categories of equipment:

- Explosive device mitigation and remediation equipment
- Terrorism incident prevention equipment
- Physical security enhancement equipment
- Cyber security enhancement equipment
- Detection equipment

4. Training
5. Exercises
6. Management and Administration

TSGP Award Timeline: The SAA is responsible for obligating TSGP funds to the appropriate individual transit agencies within forty-five (45) days of the receipt of funds.

Port Security Grant Program (PSGP)

PSGP funds are primarily intended to assist ports in enhancing maritime domain awareness, improving risk management capabilities to prevent, detect, respond to and recover from attacks involving improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and other non-conventional weapons, as well as training and exercises and TWIC implementation.

PSGP Allowable Costs: Allowable expenses must fall under one of the following categories:

1. Maritime Domain Awareness/TWIC

- Deployment of access control/standardized credentialing systems.
- Deployment of detection and surveillance equipment.
- Development/enhancement of information sharing systems, including equipment (and software) required to receive, transmit, handle, and store classified information.
- Creation/enhancement of maritime community watch programs.
- Construction/enhancements of command and control facilities.
- Enhancement of interoperable communications/asset tracking for sharing terrorism threat information (including ensuring that mechanisms are interoperable with Federal, State, and local agencies).

2. IED prevention, protection, response and recovery capabilities
3. Training and exercises
4. Management and administration

PSGP Award Timeline: The State's pass-through period must be met within 60 days of the award date for the PSGP.

Intercity Bus Security Grant Program (IBSGP)

The IBSGP provides funding to create a sustainable program for the protection of intercity bus systems and the traveling public from terrorism. The program seeks to assist operators of fixed-route intercity and charter bus services in obtaining the resources required to support security measures such as enhanced planning, facility security upgrades, and vehicle and driver protection.

IBSGP Allowable Costs: Allowable expenses must fall under one of the following categories:

1. Facility Security Enhancements:

IBSGP funds may be used on projects that focus on lighting, fencing, securing gates, door access codes, cameras, etc.

2. Vehicle/Driver Security Enhancements:

Vehicle security enhancements focus on theft prevention, real-time bus inventory and inventory control, tracking, monitoring, and locating technologies. Driver security enhancements focus on protection for the bus driver to prevent would-be terrorists from immobilizing the driver and/or hijacking the bus.

3. Passenger Screening
4. Training
5. Exercises
6. Development of Vulnerability Assessments/Security Plans
7. Management and Administration
